General English

We offer all levels from Beginner to Proficiency (A1 to C2). Our qualified, native level English teachers use a course book written by experts as the syllabus for your lesson and they add extra material according to your needs. Each lesson lasts three hours. You can study part-time (6, 9 or 12 hours per week at Golders Green) or full-time (15 hours per week). Each session includes a 15 minute break.

Our courses are designed to help you improve all aspects of your English:

Grammar	Learn, revise and extend your knowledge of English grammar
Speaking	Learn to speak more fluently and to express complex ideas
Pronunciation	Improve your pronunciation
Reading	Increase your reading speed and learn how to skim and scan texts

Vocabulary	Learn new words and increase your vocabulary

Exam Preparation Classes

• First Certificate in English

(FCE - Cambridge Level 3 - B2 Common European Framework)

• Certificate in Advanced English

(CAE - Cambridge Level 4 - C1 Common European Framework); This exam is recognised by the majority of British universities as fulfilling entrance requirements in English language.

• Certificate of Proficiency in English

(CPE - Cambridge Level 5 - C2 Common European Framework); This exam is recognised as fulfilling English language entry requirements in English language by British universities and universities in other English-speaking countries.

• International English language Testing System

(IELTS); This exam is taken by students wishing to go to university. Universities usually request a score of 6.5 to 7.5 (B2 - C2) as a minimum entry requirement.

Enrolment

You may enrol in person any weekday (excluding bank holidays and holidays), during office hours. You may also enrol by phone, email or post. A college certificate is awarded to every student who successfully completes a course of study.

Juniors and Groups: We accept junior groups of under 16s at Golders Green College throughout the year.

16-18 Year Olds: Most students on our English courses are over 18 years old however, we do accept students aged 16-17. Please contact us for more details.

Student Visas

Students come from many countries. Those outside the EU may have to apply for a visa. Make sure you give full details of why you want to study.

You need a detailed study plan and you will need to supply detailed financial information. Our daytime classes (15 hours per week) qualify as full-time courses of study in the UK. The certificate of enrolment, required for visa applications, is issued by the College on full payment of fees. Please apply to the embassy in your own country for full details.
